Last Week:

We thank Tad Peck for bringing the Vermilion Fire Marshall, Roger Sick and John Showalter, the Fire Inspector to give us a talk and to describe the local Fire Department and a couple of new programs in store for the City. Roger said the fire trucks of today all have on-board computers on each of them. He stated that they carry lots of water right on the vehicles. The department owns three pumpers with a one thousand gallon water capacity each. The water tanker has a three thousand gallon capacity and two other units with one thousand gallon capacity each. The department owns several pickup trucks and jeeps also. Roger said the department's job status is to try to prevent fires. He said the Fire Marshall's job is to inspect the local business establishments to see if he can offer any suggestions as to how to improve their facilities in order to make them a safer place to work and conduct business. Roger also explained a new program the department is introducing to Vermilion businesses, the Knox-box Rapid Entry System. By the

use of his "power-point" program and the projector, he showed the group the Knox-Box is like a small safe which is installed on the commercial building. In the case of a fire or other emergency, the box allows the firemen to enter the box, obtain the key (s) to the building to quickly and easily enter and do their work. This heavy duty key box is used for most commercial applications including schools, government and public buildings, community associations and apartment complexes. The company now has Knox-boxes for single family residences. The box can be mounted permanently near the door or directly on the door. The box can be used temporarily on homes if the person is going on vacation or on a business trip out of town. The second program the team showed the members and guests was a computerized laser driven fire extinguisher training system called the "BullsEye." It is used to train firemen and business employees how to discharge and use dry-chemical or CO2 extinguishers by computer simulation. He said the training can now take place completely indoors, in the actual work environment. It makes training to OSHA requirements safe and easy. The program was very interesting, educational, and timely.
