The following is taken from the Rotary By-laws.

“Article 3 Election of Directors and Officers
Section 1 - At least one month prior to the meeting for the election of officers, (in Oct or Nov.), the president shall ask the nominating committee to meet for the purpose of establishing a slate to be presented to the membership at the annual meeting. The nominating committee shall be made up of the sitting president, the immediate past president, the president-elect, the secretary, and the outgoing members of the Board (terms will expire on June 30). The nominating committee will submit the following slate after consulting with the individual members as to their willingness and desire to serve the club. These terms will actively begin on July 1, but the planning for the year will begin in January. The following positions need to be named; President (the sitting President-Elect), President-Elect (the sitting Vice-President or another Board member), a 2 year Director (someone new from the general membership), a 2 year Director (someone new from the general
